Aims of the Course

- To bring the core theory of Implementation Science (IS) to health and social care practitioners and to support the application of IS in the health and social care domains of practice
- To critically appraise and analyse the factors facilitating and impeding implementation in a variety of settings
- To foster multi-disciplinary learning in an academic setting where the multi-disciplinary and multi-organisational backgrounds of the students are developed as a source of learning.

Course Learning Outcomes

- 1 Identify, source and critically appraise the academic literature on implementation science
- 2 Apply the core concepts of implementation science to (a) workplace project(s)
- 3 Identify and critically analyse what impedes implementation in a variety of health and social care environments
- 4 Correctly identify the stakeholders and appropriate skills needed for implementation of a chosen workplace project
- 5 Identify and critically analyse the role of individual and organisational behaviour in influencing change
- Identify and apply the knowledge skills and professional competence relevant and necessary to the practice of human resource management

Course Learning Outcomes (cont'd)

- Reflect on their own experiences of organisational change and develop ways of helping themselves and other organisational members through the process of change.
- 9 Apply the principles of project management to (a) workplace project(s)
- 10 Appraise data and available information systems necessary for measurement of implementation.
- 11 Correctly apply the parameters needed for evaluation of (a) workplace project(s)
- 12 Present findings of investigations in a suitably academic written form –assignments.

Course Structure

30 ECTs credits in a total of six modules:

- Core Elements of Implementation Science Part 1 (5 credits)
- Core Elements of Implementation Science Part 2 (5 credits)
- Management and Organisational Behaviour in Implementation (5 credits)
- Human Resource Mangagement for Implementation (5 credits)
- Project Management for Implementation (5 credits)
- Information for implementation (5 credits)

Each 5 credits -100 hours of learning

- 18 hours face to face teaching, case studies, group work, workshops
- 40 hours assignments (six in total)
- 42 hours self-directed learning including pre-reading material, on-line material and recommended reading. Course materials available via Virtual Learning Environment

 - Case study examples -leading policymakers and senior managers in the wider Irish health, social care and education systems

 - HR policies on recruitment, retention, coaching, teams
