- Established in 2011, and now in its 6th year. 11 meetings of the network to date
- **Steering Group**, established in 2012, advises on future development of the Network

- Currently 100 members, including senior policy makers, service providers, practitioners and researchers in Ireland and
 Northern Ireland Looking to strengthen the 'researcher' member base and members in Northern Ireland
